Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to authorise recreational fishers to take and possess southern bluefin tuna (*Thunnus maccoyii*), which is an endangered species under the *Fisheries Management Act 1994*, subject to compliance with any requirements imposed by or under that Act that apply to or in respect of the taking and possession of southern bluefin tuna.

This Order is made under section 221IA of the *Fisheries Management Act 1994*.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Fisheries Management (Southern Bluefin Tuna) Order 2014*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published in the Gazette.

3 Recreational fishers may take and possess southern bluefin tuna

A recreational fisher may take and possess southern bluefin tuna (*Thunnus maccoyii*) subject to compliance with any requirements imposed by or under the *Fisheries Management Act 1994* that apply to or in respect of the taking and possession of southern bluefin tuna.
