Section 8 Notification – Fishing Closure

Penrhyn Estuary (Botany Bay)

Condition: This schedule applies to all species of fin fish and shellfish, including but not limited to oysters, cockles, crabs, prawns, limpets, sea urchins and lobsters.

This fishing closure is effective for a period of five (5) years commencing on publication of this notification, unless sooner amended revoked.
