

Abalone viral ganglioneuritis (AVG) Important Information for Consumers

Help protect NSW abalone stocks

Imported abalone can potentially pose a risk to NSW abalone stocks. To help reduce this risk please:

- Throw abalone shells, gut and any leftover abalone waste in the bin do not discard any abalone remains in waterways.
- Do not use abalone gut as bait in NSW it is illegal and there is a fishing closure prohibiting this activity.

- 殻や内臓、その他アワビの残骸は全てゴミ箱に入れるようにして下さい 残骸を決して 水路に投棄しないように。
- NSW 州内では、アワビの内臓を釣り餌として使用しないで下さい これは違法であり、この行為を禁じた漁業規制があります。
